Los Angeles, CA (June 8, 2010) - Award-winning singer, songwriter, speaker, author and Grammy nominee, Kathy Troccoli, to release her highly anticipated project, *Heartsongs*, on June 8, 2010 through Green Hill Music, in conjunction with a national tour.

With the release of *Heartsongs*, Kathy feels that this is the music “she was meant to make,” singing her own beloved renditions of songs that have helped form and shape her own musical career and the voice that has endeared fans to her for years.

Kathy is known throughout the world for her musical and vocal talent showcased by many Top 10 mainstream/pop radio hits such as “Everything Changes” (#1), “If I’m Not in Love,” “Tell Me Where It Hurts” and “You’ve Got a Way.” She has been named as one of *Billboard* magazine’s Top Twenty Adult Contemporary Artists of the Year and achieved *Billboard*’s Top Forty Adult Contemporary Song of the Year.

Over the past 28 years, Troccoli has amassed 19 recordings, 17 #1 radio hits, 3 Grammy nominations, 19 Dove Award nominations and 2 Dove Awards. She has also appeared on *The Tonight Show*, *VH-1*, *CNN Showbiz*, *Entertainment Tonight*, *Good Day NY*, *Live! with Regis and Kathie Lee* and has been featured in *Entertainment Weekly*, *New York Times*, *LA Times*, *New York Newsday*, *Billboard* and *Music Express Spotlight Network 40*, among many others.

In *Heartsongs*, uber alto crooner Kathy Troccoli crosses acoustic elements similar to Eva Cassidy and subtle jazz stylings hinting of Norah Jones with a taste of Sarah Vaughan’s vocal coloring to create a unique sound on this collection of nostalgic "heartsongs" from the eclectic songbooks of James Taylor, Stevie Wonder, Carole King, Elton John, Al Green and The Beatles.

Times when life was “simpler” and “sweet” are remembered in stirring renditions of musical classics like Simon and Garfunkel’s “Feelin’ Groovy,” Louis Armstrong’s “What a Wonderful World” and The Drifters’ “Up on the Roof.”

Twelve timeless songs that resonate with all generations are compiled in *Heartsongs*. Bringing her famous jazz emotion and soulful vocals to each track, Troccoli has created an album that pays homage to amazing music with a powerful and timeless sound.
